



BLAME IT ON THE UKULELE **6/7/24**

And [C] then I knew, I'd [G7] buy a uke that [C\] day




Blame it on the uku [G7] lele, with it's magic [C] spell

Blame it on the [G7] ukulele, the sound of [C] love . . . C\




Boys

[C] The [F] sound of [C] love.


Girls
