Also using [A7] can be useful - may be easier than barre

I'll be [Bb] sittin' when the evenin' [G] comes
[F] Watching the ships roll [A7] in
And I [Bb] watch 'em roll away a-[G]gain

[F] Sitting on the dock of the [D7] bay
watching the [F] tide roll a-[D7]way
I'm just [F] sittin' on the dock of the [G] bay wastin' [F] time

I [F] left my home in [A7] Georgia
[Bb] Headed for the 'Frisco [G] bay
'Cause [F] I had nothin to [A7] live for
And look like [Bb] nothing's gonna come my [G] way

So I'm just gonna [F] Sit on the dock of the [D7] bay
watching the [F] tide roll a-[D7]way
I'm [F] sittin' on the dock of the [G] bay wastin' [F] time
